Patricia Le Roux died Saturday night in Paris, hit by a scooter

Who was Patricia?

Those who knew her, writes: "She was a loving mother, a loyal friend, a doctor, a homeopath, a musician, leader of a choir, writer, manager. She spoke fluently as well as French, English, German and Italian.

Her commitment in every field was given with heart; she had an inexhaustible energy and surprised for the amount of work that she was able to do. She wrote books, taught, held leading positions .

In each of these rules Patricia was excellent; no mediocre vote in the report she will submit to her final exam, a pre appeal for her young age.

Pediatrician and Homeopath she was Homeopathy trained in Medicine Faculty of Marsiglia where now she taught, professor of Homeopathy at the SHO of Netherlands, in Glasgow and in Eastern Countries as part of the ECH team "Flying Doctors of Europe": Russia, Latvia, Slovakia. She held several conferences in France.

She was ECH General Secretary (European committee for homeopathy) in Bruxelles, the association that brings all European Homeopathic Abbreviations. In France she was vice president of the most representative Homeopathic Physicians Trade Union (more than 600 members) and in charge for Marseille University Bioethics Committee. She worked in the pediatric oncology department of Marseille taking care of more difficult chronic cases. She studied Materia Medica with a Homeopathic group and was involved in the work of the Hahnemannian school of Frejus directed by Didier Grandegeorge who had been her university teacher.

Some of her works: the book "Homeo and Juliet" for patients, "Actinides", the uranium remedies and its applications in Pediatrics, "Butterfly", a guide on the use of innovative butterfly remedies, "Metals in Homeopathy" , the heart and essence of the pediatric cases in the series of iron, silver and gold, "Hidro-Homeopathic Energy", a comprehensive study of use of acids in homeopathy, CD of lectures on pediatric cancer and reviews in music magazines (the homeopathie européenne, Bulletin des Pediatre Homéopathes, Les Echos du CLH .... etc.),

We had known her in Milan a few months ago. Her memory is alive, like the one that leaves an uncommon personality. Her words competent and expert, never gave to the event. I remember her slender, phosphoric hands, her smile and her feminine, elegant, slim figure, the distinct elegance. But above all else, her eyes alive and deep, behind which you guessed unintelligible mind, so much knowledge and passion for her work.
